The graduate can occupy middle technical and economic positions in the agro-complex (agricultural primary production, services for agriculture and countryside development, landscape protection and creation etc.) in organizing and managing activities related to plant growing, animal breeding, cultivation, processing of agricultural products, and preparation of accounting documents and in working in business-technical services, countryside development services (e.g. agro-tourism), landscape protection, etc. He or she is also able to do business in the agro-complex.

Possible work positions: agricultural technician - agriculturist, cattle breeder, farmer, merchant with agricultural products, cultivator, agricultural services salesman, agricultural technology salesman, independent businessman, etc.
